- ____ 7) Contributions to the betterment and practice of environmental health profession, including publications, scientific or applied research, development or implementation of new or improved concepts, procedures, etc. (40%)
- ____ 8) Other contributions to civic or school activities or affiliations, previous recognition, honors and awards (Community Involvement - 5%)
- ____ 9) Letters of reference or endorsement and other support documents (10%)
