

Enforcement



- OCR has received and investigated a record number of Breach Reports
- Decreased OCR enforcement staff
- OCR fines + criminal penalties + civil lawsuit settlements







- Mitigates fines
- Decreases/eliminates length and extent of audit in response to a breach
- Mitigates remedies in a HIPAA resolution agreement with HHS



Top Challenges – Privacy & Breach Notification

- Timely Access to Records
- Insufficient sharing of Privacy Practices
- Deficient Privacy Training
- Timely Breach Notification
- Inadequate Breach Notification content



Top Challenges – Security

- Timely Risk Analysis
- Insufficient Risk Management
- Deficient audit and activity monitoring
- User access controls
- Deficient Business Associates

- Deficient Risk Analysis

- CE to CE BAAs


