The seal was designed and adopted in 1958 as the official insignia for the N. C. P. H. A. The shield of blue on a white field represents honor, purity and sincerity of purpose. The seven dogwood (State flower) blossoms represent the original Sections of the N. C. P. H. A. The Tar Heel State, represented by the pine cone atop the shield. The circling bands, of course, represent the cooperative spirit and unity of purpose of the whole program — "For Community Health".
