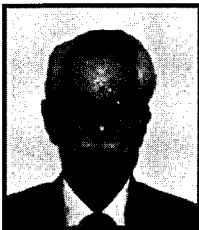

A Historical Note

“State Medicine and Preventable Diseases”

The city of Fayetteville holds a unique place in North Carolina public health history. It was here on May 3, 1876, at the annual meeting of the North Carolina Medical Society that Dr. Solomon Sampson Satchwell of Rocky Point in Pender County presented a paper entitled “State Medicine and Preventable Diseases.” The minutes of the Medical Society of 1876 indicate that Dr. Satchwell’s presentation was “a clear, forceful argument in favor of the establishment of a State Board of Health.” This forceful argument created great interest among those gathered at the meeting and a committee was appointed to attend the next session of the General Assembly for the purpose of convincing members of the Assembly of the need for a State Board of Health in North Carolina. The members of the committee were: Dr. S. S. Satchwell of Pender County; Dr. R. L. Payne of Davidson County; Dr. Marcellus Whitehead of Rowan County, and Dr. George Foote of Warren County. According to Dr. B. E. Washburn “the committee went to Raleigh in 1877 for the meeting of the General Assembly and remained there for most of the session, being joined by Drs. Eugene Grisson and M. J. Pittman. These doctors were successful in securing the passage on February 12, 1877 of a bill to establish the North Carolina State Board of Health.”¹ The roots of public health in North Carolina are in this place. Listen and you may hear echoes of Dr. Satchwell’s speech and you will know of the power of the spoken word and of community commitment.

It took our Association many years to discover the magic of Fayetteville. The 70th Annual Meeting was held here September 15-18, 1981. The theme of the meeting was “Caution: Decade of Hazards” which could certainly serve as a theme for this gathering also. Our second meeting here was held September 15-18, 1987 and the theme was “Public Health: We Care” which would also make a nice theme for us. Mr. Stacy Covil served as president of the Association in 1987 and we look forward to him presenting awards at the banquet on Thursday evening of this annual meeting. Our previous gatherings in Fayetteville have been educational, informative, and fun and we appreciate all the work and preparation done for this, our third meeting in the “All American City.” It is worthy of note that in 1912, Robeson County, which is located thirty miles south of here, established the first rural health department in the United States. A state historic marker on the town square in Lumberton commemorates this important occasion.

Dr. Satchwell ended his now famous presentation with these words:

“Then let us, amid all the disadvantages and discouragements which are now so peculiar to our profession here, move on with unfailing hearts and unfaltering steps in the high mission of curing and preventing disease. And pledging anew our devotion to our Society (Association) which has done so much good, and triumphed over so many difficulties . . . ”²

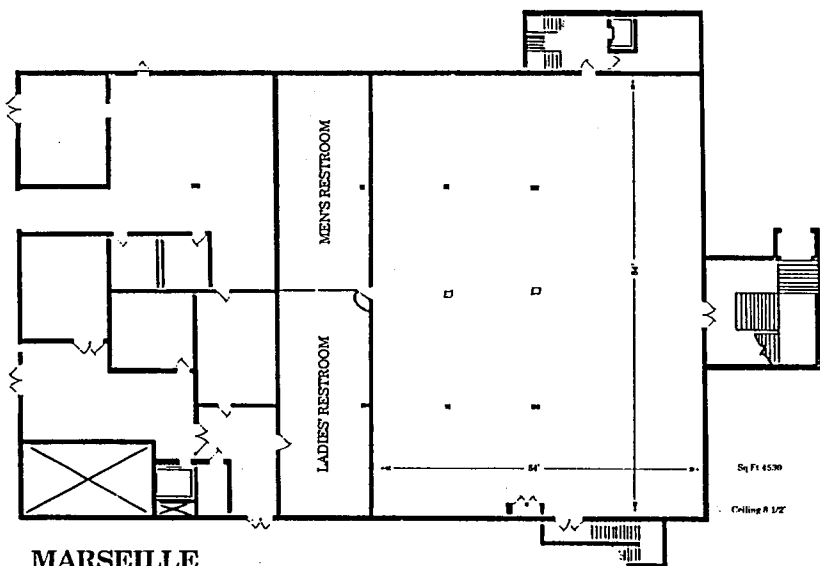
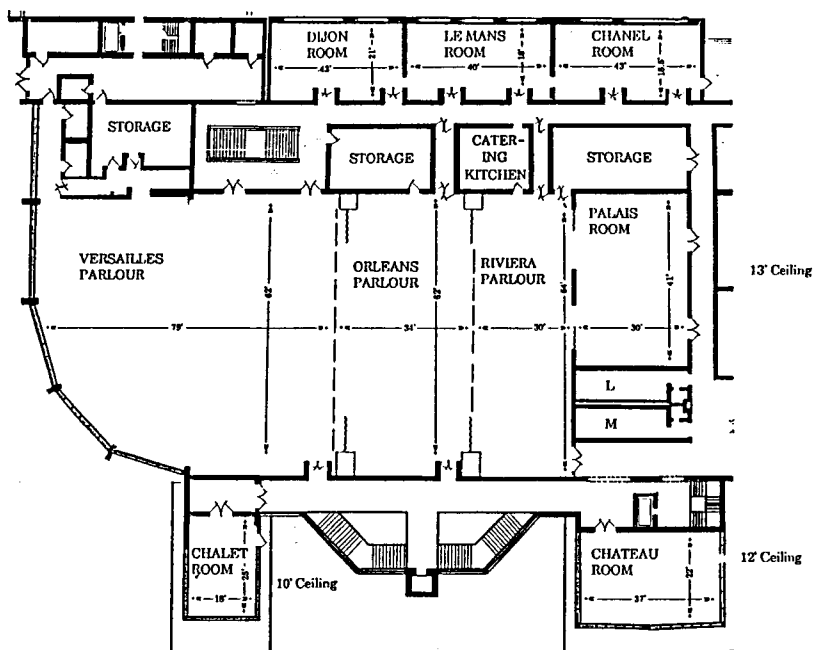
